



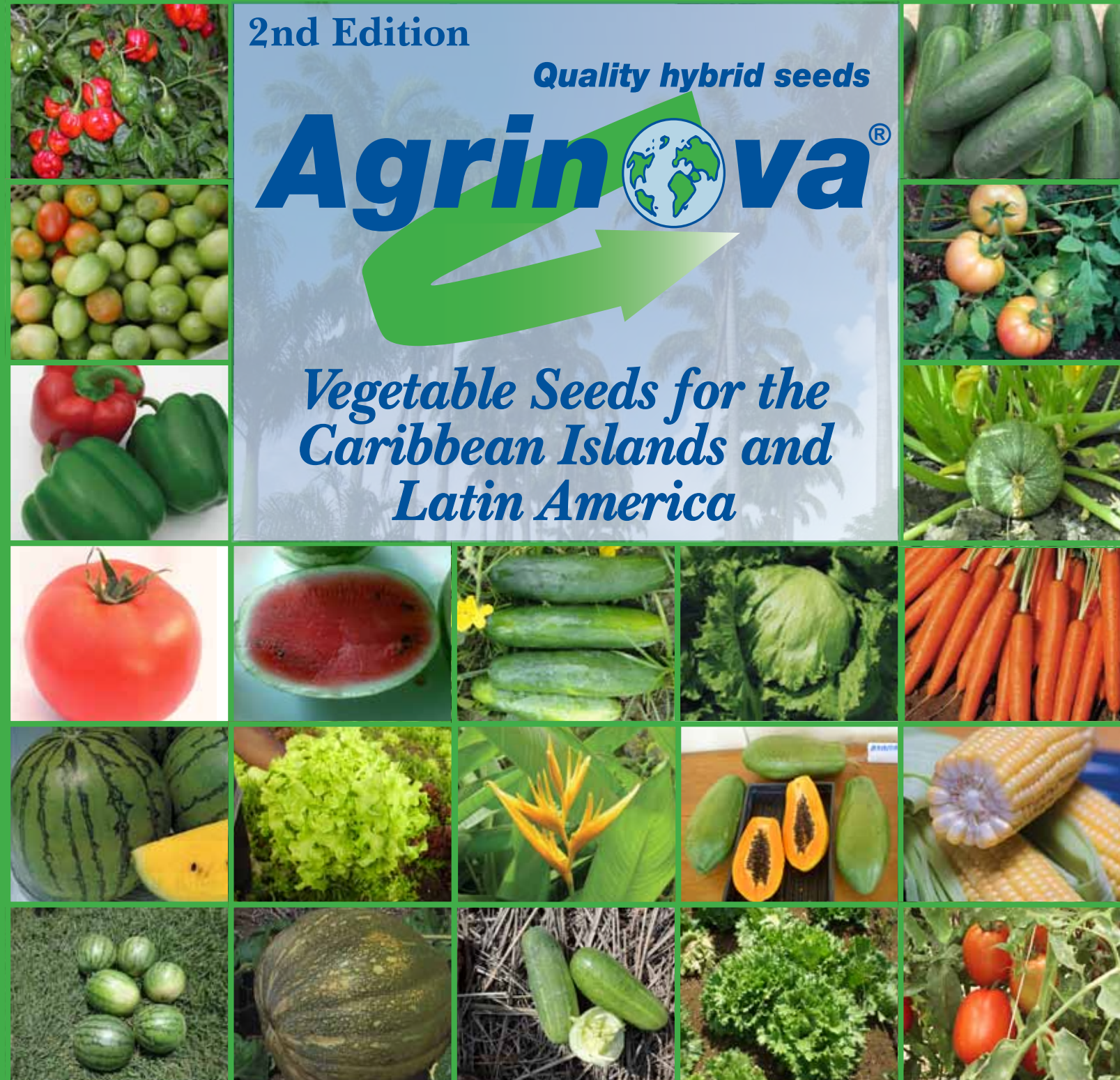

We also work with a laboratory in California when further analysis is required and for our improved hybrid varieties that are sold as pelleted seeds.

Our seeds are supplied with a fungicide treatment (usually thiram) unless special request from customers for organic or non-treated seeds.

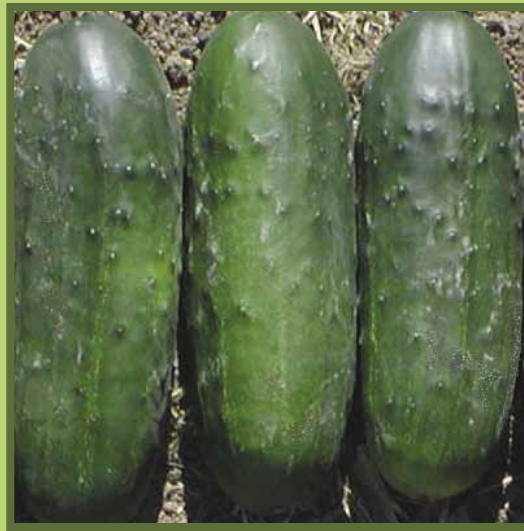
Cucumber F1 Kalima
